I am directed to refer to your email dated 08.09.2023, 15.9.2023 and 17.10.2023 on the subject mentioned above. Based on the information/certificates provided by M/s. Indogulf Crop Sciences Ltd., Delhi for not claiming subsidy on the intended export, No Objection Certificate is hereby granted for exporting **500 Kg of NPK 19:19:19 to Iraq** for the year 2023-24, subject to the condition that the company shall submit the truck/Train tariff receipts as well as customs clearance to show that the quantity shown in the NOC matches with the quantity actually exported with a variation of plus -minus 15%. And if there will be violations of any of the conditions and undertaking given by them, they shall be liable for action as per FCO.

2. As far as export permission for other products viz. NPK 13:00:45 is concerned, it is informed that NPK 13:00:45 is classified as a water-soluble complex fertilizer under Schedule-I, Part A 1(i) of FCO, 1985 and is not covered under Nutrient Based Subsidy (NBS) scheme of Government of India. This product is also not covered under DGFT Notification No. 49/2015-2020 dated 07.01.2019 and therefore D/o Fertilizers has no comments to offer. You are thus requested to contact D/o Commerce/DGFT for export permission of these products.
