5. Incremental progress of Talcher fertilizer projects during November 2023.

(A). REVIVAL OF TALCHER UNIT:

Government of India mandated revival of Talcher unit of M/s FCIL, located in Angul district, Odisha. Accordingly, a Joint Venture Company named Talcher Fertilizers Ltd. (TFL) has been incorporated for setting up coal gasification-based (first time in India) Ammonia urea plant of 12.7 LMTPA capacity. Foundation of the plant was laid by Hon'ble Prime Minister on 17th February, 2019. Equity of GAIL, RCF & CIL in TFL is 31.85% each and that of FCIL is 4.45%. The project activities are being regularly monitored by DoF. The overall progress of the TFL project is as under:

a) Overall progress of Project up to October, 2023 : 51.89 % b) Incremental progress during November, 2023 0.87 % 52.76 %

c) Overall progress up to November, 2023

The project is reviewed regularly by the Secretary, Department of Fertilizer since July 2023.

- Following are the major activities and achievements during the month of November, 2023:-2. i.
 - **Construction Related Activities:**
 - a. Installation of Ammonia Storage Tank-A completed.
 - b. Erection of 2 out of 5 Ammonia Plant Cooling Tower completed.
 - c. Two Molecular Sieve Adsorber (set-2) in Air Separation Unit erected at site.
 - d. Water panel in Boiler -1(pressure part) erection completed.

ii. **HR Related Activities:**

- Sh. Deepak Gupta, Director-Projects, GAIL has been appointed as the new Chairman, TFL on 17.11.2023.
- Out of 1387 applications received for various posts, 960 candidates were found eligible for interviews after scrutiny of documents. 25 candidates (Safety, HR, Legal and Contract & Procurement) have been issued appointment letters after interview in the 1st 2nd phases. Interviews are still in progress.
- All RCF & CIL manpower has been shifted from Noida & Bhubaneshwar office to Talcher.

iii) Miscellaneous Activities:

- * A Skill Development Plan has been prepared and is under considerations for finalization.
- * Out of the proposed laying of 13km pipeline from Brahmani river, lying of 4 km has been
- * As regard the Ash handling Package, the route has been finalized and offers have been received from prospective bidders.
- * Draft CCEA Note for additional equity infusion by RCF in the TFL project has been circulated for Inter-Ministerial Consultation (IMC) on 05.12.2023.

5. Expenditure position:

As against total available budget B.E. of Rs. 184128.48 Crore for F.Y. 2023-24, expenditure on administration of fertilizer subsidy during November 2023 was Rs.13019.54 Crore (Urea: Rs. 7327.12 Crore, P&K: Rs. 5688.84 Crore, DBT 3.31 Crore, R&D0.20 Crore & Capital Expenditure 0.07 Corer). Progressive expenditure during April 2023 to November 2023 was Rs. 136023.09 crore (Urea: Rs. 86987.47 crore & P&K: Rs. 49004.12 crore, DBT 2.23 Crore & Capital Expenditure 1.18 Corer) i.e. the approx. 73.87 % of the total allocation.
